LEARN OR REFRESH MORSE CODE

Do you or someone you know want to learn Morse code? If so the K6RAU Code Course is now available on the internet. This is **actual** code instruction, not code practice as one does not need to know a "dit" from a "dah" to learn. Simply with paper and pencil in hand follow the voice instruction. The narrator is Fred K6DUU (now a SK), father of K6RAU Fred our Treasurer. The course was first broadcast on 160 meters to local Merced/Modesto area boy scouts listening on converted music radios. 

Membership Dues Renewal Application

Dues are \$10.00 for first year joining and then \$8.00 for any consecutive years you want to pay for, so for 2 years it would be \$18.00. It only becomes \$10.00 when you fail to renew your membership by the due date or are a first time member. By failing to renew on time you also jeopardize your continuous service awards. Associate membership is for spouses, children or military personnel living at the same address as member and is an additional \$4.00 per year.
