

Reducing the cost of yearly Elections

Earlier in the year, there was considerable discussion on how to reduce the cost of our yearly elections due to postal expenses. These methods included internet sites such as SurveyMonkey, BallotBin, etc. Unfortunately, these ended up being expensive and/or complicated, especially with numbers exceeding 100 ballots.

Many of you probably saw an email I sent out September 9th asking for volunteers to help to determine email addresses for WPSS members. At that time, I had identified the emails of 272 of the 399 current members, which left 127 unknown emails.

The reason for determining member emails is to facilitate being able to make the newsletter/ballot available to members either on the web, or via email. Until now, WPSS mailed ~399 hard copies, with a considerable postage expense. We will always need to mail some hard copies, but not nearly the numbers in the past.

In response to the email, about 15 members volunteered to call members with no known email address or email addresses that have failed (changes, etc.).

I wish to thank the following members who volunteered to make the calls:

As a result of this effort (which is still ongoing) we have whittled down the number of unknowns from 127 to 88 members, with more reductions expected.

Ideally we would not have to mail any hard copies, but this is not realistic since not everyone has an email address and/or internet access. Accordingly, every WPSS member should be aware of the election/Ballot/ in one or more of the following methods:

Active monitoring of the net, where announcements will be made about elections.

Access to the ballot/newsletter on the WPSS site,

Emailed copies,

Hard copy in the mail for those without access electronically.

The ballot will be a PDF file that can be filled-out electronically and saved with your entries. So, those who get the ballot from the web or email, can save their entered vote and either email to the Treasurer or print and snail-mail a hardcopy to the Treasurer.

Membership Dues Renewal Application

Dues are \$12.00 for first year joining and then \$10.00 for any consecutive years you want to pay for, so for 2 years it would be \$22.00. It only becomes \$12.00 when you fail to renew your membership by the due date or are a first time member. By failing to renew on time you also jeopardize your continuous service awards. Associate membership is for spouses, children or military personnel living at the same address as member and is an additional \$4.00 per year.

You can check the By Laws on the website, Article III Membership Sections 1 & 2 and Article IV Dues Sections 1-5; if unsure you can check with **Toby W6PXD**, **WPSS Membership Chairman**.

Dues are \$10.00 if your membership is current. You can renew or rejoin now by sending your dues to the Treasurer Dave K6DAW. If unsure as to your member status you can check the website member listing or you can e-mail Dave k6dawdave@gmail.com
